Relay For Life is the American Cancer Society's signature activity. It offers everyone in a community an opportunity to participate in the fight against cancer. Teams of people camp out at a local high school, park, or fairground and take turns walking or running around a track or path. Each team is asked to have a representative on the track at all times during the event. Relays are an overnight event, up to 24 hours in length.

Already, US JAYCEES members are forming teams, volunteering at their local Relay events, and educating their friends about cancer prevention and early detection.

Register Online and Begin Fundraising

As a member of the United States Junior Chamber, you can register your Chapter as a Relay Team through the Jaycees exclusive registration site. Below are the first steps to register your Chapter as a Relay For Life team through the National Team Program...it's easy!

1. Visit www.Relayforlife.org
2. Select **"Find your Event"** from the center buttons and navigate to the page for your relay event.
3. Select **"Sign up"**
4. Click on **"Join a team"** or **"Start a team"**
5. Put in your zip code to locate the Relay events closest to you.
6. Choose the Relay event you would like to participate in, and then click on **"event web site"**
7. Fill out the registration information.
 - o Please include your 2 letter state abbreviation in your team name.
 - o Make sure you use the drop down box and choose **"Jaycees"** as your **"team/company organization!"** (This is so you will be able to receive a FREE Relay team banner like the one you see above!)
8. While at your event website, click on the box at the top of the page that says **"National Teams."** Then **"Non Corporate Teams"** This will take you to a page that lists our non corporate team partners. Click on the Jaycees logo, where you will be able to follow the number of teams and dollars that is raised through the Jaycees! **DIRECT LINK** **Bookmark this page, as you will want to visit it often!**
